Knot Fidd'n - banish the groove cliffs

Knot Fidd'n *Turning* [self-released KF1381 (2006)] The Ohio-based Celtic-American band Knot Fidd'n generally seems to highlight the percussive aspect of the tunes it has chosen for its fourth CD release, basing the accordion, guitar, and whistle on the groove. That's not a bad thing; in fact, it seems to be a nice focus for the character and energy of the band. The recording includes both traditional music and composed pieces, three songs, and nine sets of tunes, among them "The Cliffs of Moher," "Banish Misfortune," and "Wave Over Wave."
